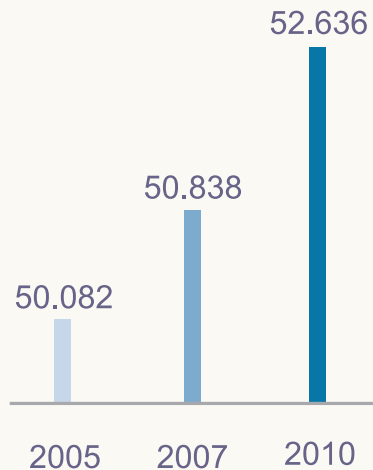

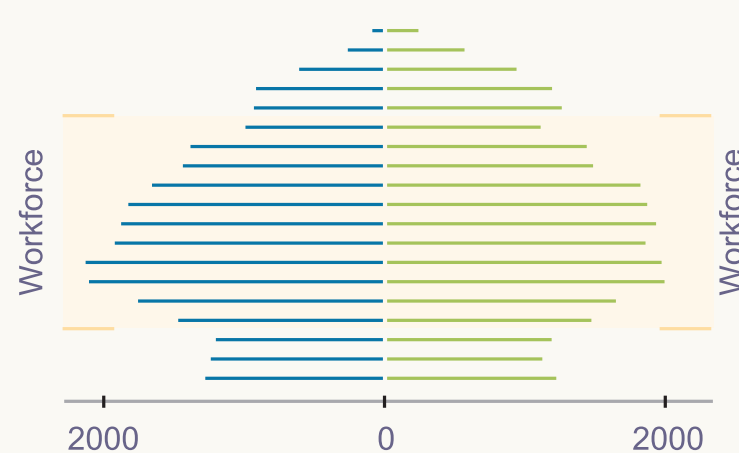
Puertollano, a city for investment

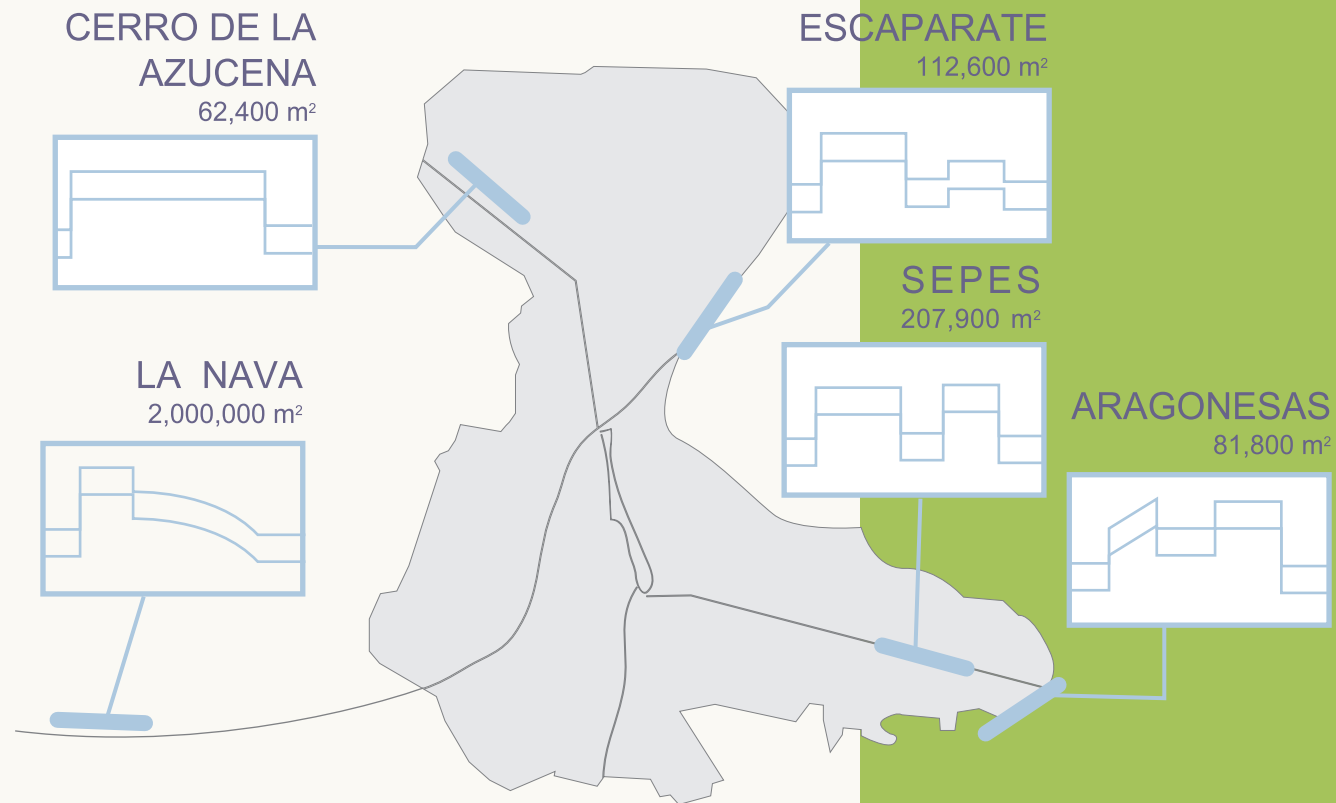

Drains and sewage systems.

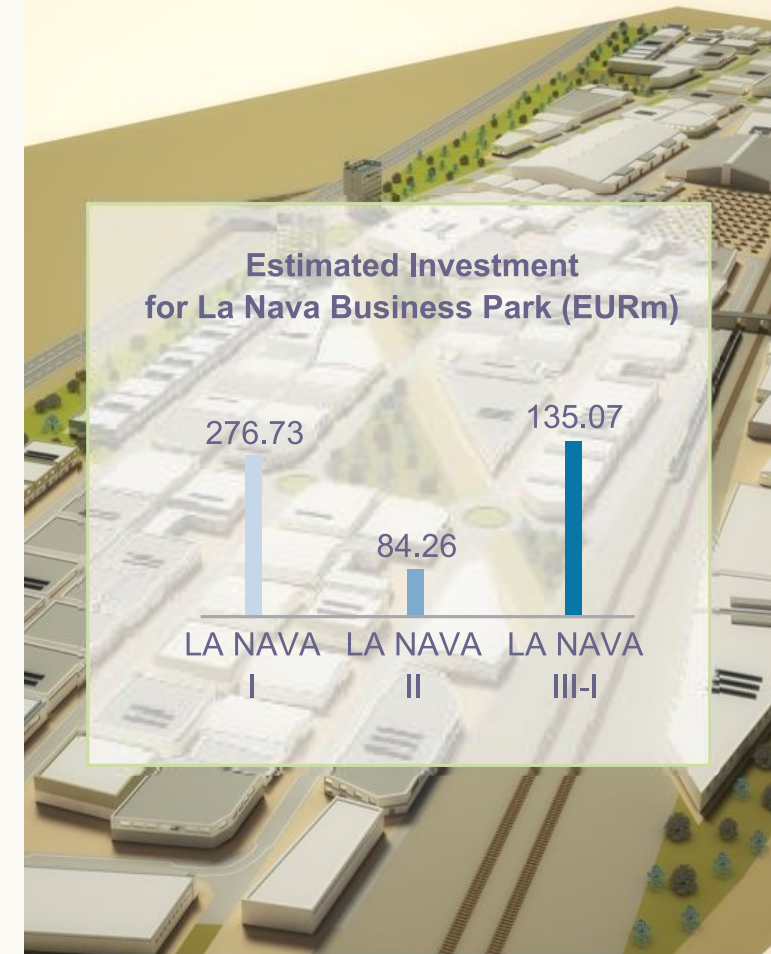

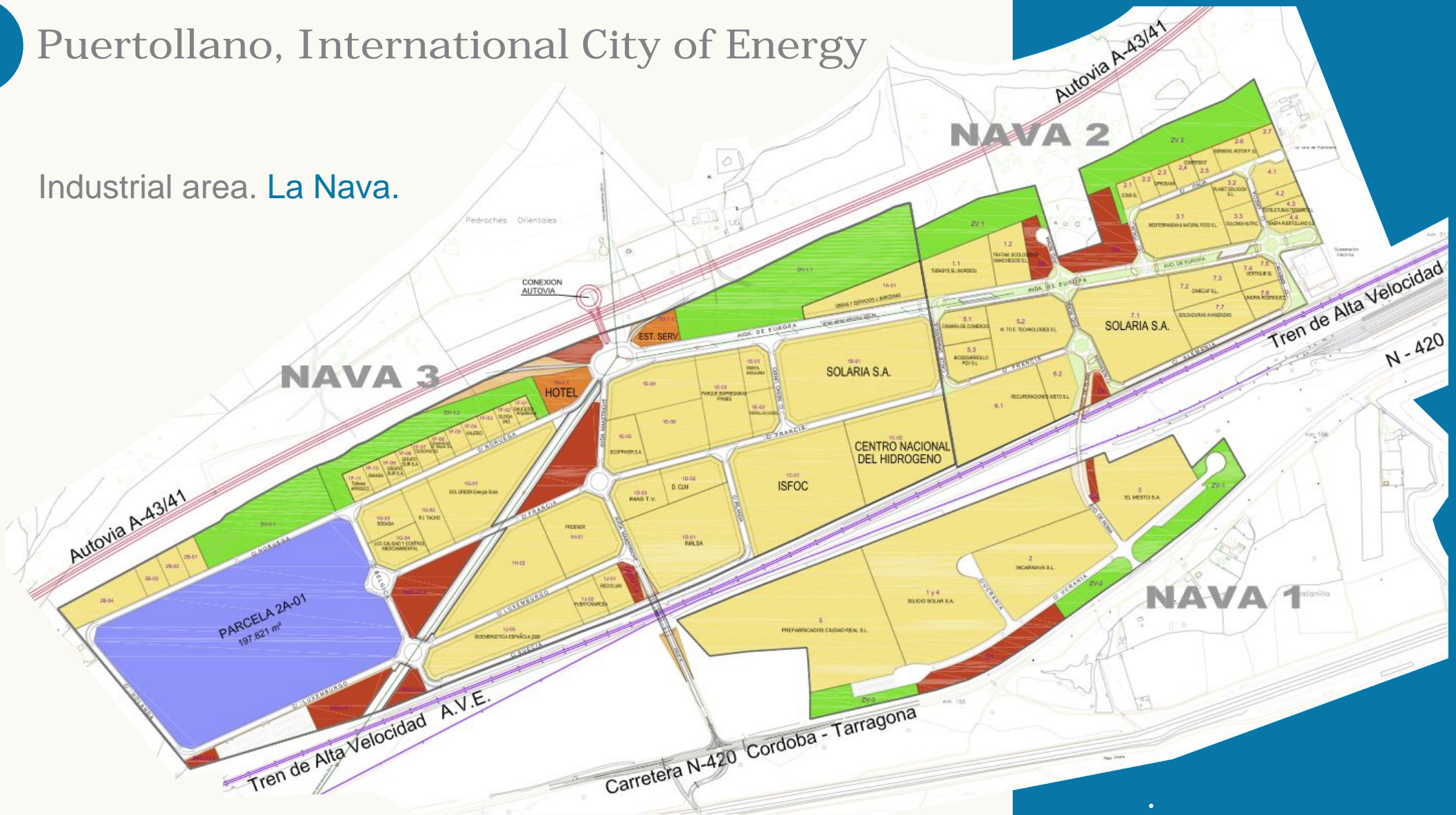
